

- 3. The facts contained in this affidavit do not set forth all of my knowledge about this matter but are based upon the following: my own personal knowledge; knowledge obtained from other individuals during my participation in this investigation, including other law enforcement officers; my review of records related to this investigation; communications with others who have knowledge of the events and circumstances described herein; and information gained through my training and experience.

- 5. My conclusion that such probable cause exists is based on the following factual information:
- On September 14<sup>th</sup>, 2017 I spoke with Eric Verhille, employed as a Maine State Police Trooper. He told me that on a day in January, 2017, he and another trooper went to serve a criminal summons on Nicholas Worthing, date of birth:

  Worthing's residence,

  for the crime of Stalking (in relation to a separate case). Tpr. Verhille described the stalking incident as "Cyber-Stalking", commonly known as repeatedly using electronic communications to harass, frighten and/or threaten someone.
- 7. Tpr. Verhille said Worthing refused to sign the criminal summons. Worthing was told the signature was only an acknowledgment of receipt of the summons, that it was legally required and was a separate arrestable offense for refusing to sign the summons. Worthing continued to refuse to sign the summons. Tpr. Verhille said he and his fellow trooper made the decision not to arrest Worthing, but left the summons on his table and told him what the summons was for and his court date.
- 8. Tpr. Verhille said a short time later (that same day), dispatchers told him Nicholas Worthing had just called, wanting to know why State Troopers were at his residence. Tpr. Verhille said he and the fellow trooper responded back to the Worthing residence, to find Worthing outside screaming at them to leave his property immediately. The troopers told Worthing they came back to re-summons him for the crime of Stalking and that he needed to sign the summons. Worthing dialed 911 from his cordless phone then ran inside his residence. The troopers followed him inside and told Worthing once again he needed to sign the summons.
- 9. Once inside, Worthing told the dispatcher on the line the troopers were pointing a gun at him. Tpr. Verhille said at no point did anyone point guns at Worthing. Worthing still refused to sign the summons and was arrested for refusing to sign.

- 10. Tpr. Verhille said his wife, the said his wife, at a later date, received the following message on her Facebook account from a person listed as "Nick Worthing": "Question. Do you ever think that your husband being a low-life douchebag arresting a single father of his eight-year-old daughter on a summons that is complete bull shit. Might affect your life? Have a good night...".
- Facebook message from "Nick Worthing" sometime in May, 2017. She said she had never heard of a Nick Worthing. She read the message "Nick Worthing" sent to her a few times trying to understand it and why she was asked why it might affect her life. said it was the first time as a police officer's wife she didn't feel safe for her family as it was the first time anyone from her husband's work had ever tried to seek out her family. She asked her husband if she should be concerned and said she didn't sleep that night because she felt scared and afraid for her children and her family. said her husband took a screenshot of the post.
- On September 20<sup>th</sup>, 2017 I interviewed message from "Nick Worthing" which read: "Your sons a scum bag. Who is no good at his job. That low life broke in to my house, illegal home invasion.....In my opinion that's why there's so many cop shootings, is because of gang members like him. Fucking scum bag." After reading the message, said she was scared and didn't know why someone would write this to her. The haid she was scared for her son.
- said he first heard of Facebook messages from "Nick Worthing" being sent to his family from his daughter-in-law, who confided to him she was scared and didn't know if she should tell her husband for fear of an escalation occurring if he were to learn what "Nick Worthing" wrote to her. The hid his wife, who confided to him she was scared and didn't what "Nick Worthing" wrote to her. The hid his wife, where the second person in his family to receive a message from "Nick Worthing." Said his wife was upset and afraid their son might get hurt not knowing how crazy the person might be.

- said he thought the Facebook message sent to his wife from "Nick Worthing" was sent sometime in June 2017. Said he received 3 Facebook messages from "Nick Worthing" in a short time span sometime the third week of August 2017. The messages together read: "Your sons going to lern...Sorry bout it // You got good looking grandchildren...schools starting soon // Your sons a no good child molester and I'm going to make sure everybody in this community knows what that scumbag is".
- Gardner High School when Nick was a student there. The only thing remembered about Nick was he was a trouble-maker and had a temper. The membered no specific conflict between himself and Nick Worthing and has had no contact with him since high school.
- on his Facebook account. If felt the messages sent to his family were threatening and worried he might do something to his grandchildren, remembering the type of temper he had in high school. Wondered what his wife, daughter-in-law and his grandchildren had to do with anything and continues to be concerned why this individual would seek his family out.
- 17. In my interview with the sound on September 20<sup>th</sup>, 2017, she said once she learned her father-in-law had received a Facebook message from "Nick Worthing", she checked her Facebook account to see if any more messages had come in. Said she then read a new message from "Nick Worthing", that had been sent on June 28<sup>th</sup>, 2017, which read: "You got some cute kids. How would you feel if you had a armed home invasion for no reason?.....".
- said she received a third Facebook message from "Nick Worthing", which was sent on Friday, September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2017. The message read: "Not the heck well I guess it's a positive thing that high school student died. at least Eric can't rape her". Tpr. Verhille told me the high school student referred to in the message was repeated.

On September 14th, 2017, an email was forwarded to this affiant that was originally sent to members of the Kennebec County Sheriff's Office from Kennebec County Sheriff's Office Criminal Intelligence Analyst Randall Parker on August 30th, 2017. Analyst Parker listed screenshots of posts Nick Worthing posted on the Kennebec County Sheriff's Office Facebook page between January through August 2017. A January 25th, 2017 post read: "..?...There's a lot of ppl not happy...Hello?...We know your homes... Like your gang like to attack us at...Question. How would your kids feel of people showing up at your house...? Just a question because you douchebags would do it to us...Have a good night".
- 20. A May 29th, 2017 post send by Nick Worthing to the Kennebec County Sheriff's Office read: "Break into my house with no justified reason and there was no reason. Just ignorance. Why don't you go take out the f\*\*\*\*\* druggies around. "we can't just break into people's houses." You did it to me cunt heads! Fuck you low lifes! Most of this recent stuff is because of that no-good low-life Eric verhill. he's a state cop but all you lowlife's are all the same. I guess whatever happens. You had a heads up".
- 21. The final post Nick Worthing sent to the Kennebec County Sheriff's Office Facebook page read: "Be careful you never know what could happen at a safety check".
- 22. On September 15<sup>th</sup>, 2017, Facebook, Inc., confirmed receipt of a Preservation Request to preserve the Facebook account of "Nick Worthing" and the listed URL (web address) connected to the account. Facebook, Inc. stated they would take reasonable steps to preserve the account for 90 days.
- 23. A URL is a uniform resource locator, abbreviated as URL (also known as web address, particularly when used with <u>HTTP</u>), is a specific <u>character string</u> that constitutes a reference to a resource. In most <u>web browsers</u>, the URL of a web page is displayed on top, inside an <u>address bar</u>. An example of a typical URL would be "http://en.example.org/wiki/Main\_Page".
- 24. On September 25<sup>th</sup>, 2017, I received a document from Maine State Police Troop D Commander, Lt. Aaron Hayden, of Facebook messages sent to the Facebook account of

the Kennebec County Sheriff's Department from "Nick Worthing". One message read: "In my opinion if someone killed Eric verhille..It would be justified but I know that's just in my opinion....I'm just a daddy trying to protect his daughter but with scumbags like you out there...Idk...". Directly below this message was a picture of an adult male holding hands with a young girl, walking away from the camera, with a handgun tucked in the back waist area of the man, with what looks like a rifle strap on his back. The caption to the picture read: "When they know they're your heart And you know you are their armor And you will destroy anyone who would try to harm her". Below this post was an illustration of a large thumb's up from "Nick Worthing".

- Another message listed in this document from "Nick Worthing", posted to the Facebook account of the Kennebec County Sheriff's Department talked about police officers trespassing "at the Smelt Camps". "Nick Worthing" wrote: "I'm thinking we could do a citizen's arrest for somebody trespassing with a deadly weapon...I believe that's are right...? Isn't it?". A third message read: "In my opinion a dog is to Serve and Protect but if that dog bites you, it should get a bullet right in the f\*\*\*\* head.. Just my opinion". This was followed by a Smiley Face with a wink.
- On September 25<sup>th</sup>, I received a document from Katharine England from the Maine Department of Public Safety. The document included several messages sent to the Facebook account of the Maine State Police from "Nick Worthing" from June 14<sup>th</sup>, 2017 to June 19<sup>th</sup>, 2017. The messages open with: "Scum bags do your fucking job arrest at low life verhill for doing an illegal home invasion...Or are you just a gang that the public should rise up against?" After a series of posts, "Nick Worthing" writes: "Question. Am I able to go do my own citizen's arrest? What's required to do that? Since your game does not want to fallow the law...". "In my opinion if someone did an armed home invasion, that person should be in jail.....". "And in my opinion this is why you see the stuff that happens to Cops on TV".
- 27. "Nick Worthing" continues on then writes: "Cant say i didnt try to talk this out...Whatever happens happens...Just know I felt threatened for my life and my daughters with criminals breaking in to my home".
- 28. Lt. Aaron Hayden told me that, as a result of the messages "Nick Worthing" posted to the Maine State Police Facebook account, the Facebook account of "Nick Worthing" has been blocked. Lt. Hayden said to date, "Nick Worthing" has been the only account blocked on the Maine State Police Facebook page since its inception.
- 29. Facebook, Inc., returned records as required from a search warrant signed by Superior Court Deputy Chief Justice Robert Mullen on October 15<sup>th</sup>, 2017. Facebook records indicate the Facebook account of with "Gardiner Area High School" listed to "Nick Worthing", DOB: with "Gardiner Area High School" listed under his education. Gardiner Area High School is located near Pittston, Maine, at 40 W Hill Road, Gardiner, Maine. The "Vanity Name" was listed as "nick.worthing.5", the email address as and phone number listed as: Cell Verified on 2013-07-14 18:16:32 UTC".

- 30. A name search for the name "Verhille" within the records provided by Facebook, Inc., resulted in multiple listings.
- 31. On 04/24/17 at 11:54PM (UTC) and again on 07/22/17 at 10:52PM (UTC), the Facebook account of Nick Worthing searched for the Facebook account of "Eric Verhille".
- 32. On 04-24-17 at 11:57PM (UTC), 06-11-17 at 10:55AM (UTC), 06/22/17 at 11:01PM (UTC), and again on 08/31/17 at 5:41PM (UTC), the Facebook account of Nick Worthing searched for the photographs of the Facebook account of "Eric Verhille".
- On 09/01/17 at 2:27PM (UTC), the Facebook account of Nick Worthing searched for the Facebook account of "... "The Facebook account of Maine State Police Trooper Eric Verhille.
- On 03/28/17 at 10:34AM (UTC), on 04/24/17 at 11:55PM (UTC), and again on 06/14/17 at 5:13AM (UTC), the Facebook account of Nick Worthing searched for the Facebook account of Eric Verhille.
- 35. On 03/28/17 at 10:34AM (UTC), the Facebook account of Nick Worthing searched for the Facebook account of Maine State
  Police Trooper Eric Verhille.
- 36. On 06-14-17 at 5:09AM (UTC), the Facebook account of Nick Worthing sent the following message to the Facebook account of 'facebook account of 'facebook', mother of Maine State Police Trooper Eric Verhille:
  - "Your sons a scum bag. Who is no good at his job. That low life broke in to my house, illegal home invasion......In my opinion that's why there's so many cop shootings, is because of gang members like him. Fucking scum bag."
- 37. On 08-24-17 at 10:22PM (UTC), the Facebook account of Nick Worthing sent the following message to the Facebook account of facebook account of father of Maine State Police Trooper Eric Verhille.
  - "Your sons going to lern...Sorry bout it" and "You got good looking grandchildren...schools starting soon"
- 38. On 04-21-17 at 4:35PM (UTC), the Facebook account of Nick Worthing sent the following message to the Facebook account of the Maine State Police: "You're just a bunch of low-life scumbag gang. I wish I was proud of the police department but no you're low-life. Tell srg. Hood suck my dick. Pussy cant even show up. I bet he's a child molester. Sick fuck... Scom bags harass me with a summons that the District Attorney's office didn't even want to stick up for. All of you are lazy. Collecting welfare off of the Working Man, you pieces of shit!"

39. On 04-13-17 at 7:53AM (UTC), the Facebook account of Nick Worthing sent the following message to the personal Facebook account of Maine State Police Sergeant Patrick Hood:

"You're a skum bag. That's no good at your job. You give cops a bad name. You lieing fuck. Don't have the balls to show. Send a pee on ha. You know your summons was Bull shit. Lol the d.a. didn't even stick up for it you stupid dumb fuck. I love how my security cameras caught your officers abusing their power. I go around showing the pubic. I think that's the way to fight your gang. let the public see what kind of scumbag gang you guys are...Please Don't Shoot Me n Call of Justified, that's what you gang members are known for...Scum bags.

40. On several instances, at various dates, the Facebook account of Nick Worthing sent the following messages to the Facebook account of the Kennebec County Sheriff's Office:

"In my opinion of someone killed Eric verhill. It would be justified but I know that's just in my opinion....I'm just a daddy trying to protect his daughter but with scumbags like you out there...Idk..."

"Do you help he's the one that rapes up the ass. Poor dog.."

"In my opinion a dog is to Serve and Protect but if that dog bites you, it should get a bullet right in the f\*\*\*\*\* head. Just my opinion"

"I'm thinking we could do a citizen's arrest for somebody trespassing with a deadly weapon...I believe that's are right....? Isn't it? And don't say that I don't have the right to."

"I bet you if was breaking into your home to molesting your children he be in jail.....You worthless scum bags"

The Facebook Inc., record return confirmed the picture referred to previously in paragraph 22 of this affidavit send to the Kennebec County Sheriff's Office from the Facebook account of Nick Worthing with a colored picture of an adult male holding the hand of a young girl walking across a bridge away from the camera, and clearly holding a long gun in his left hand with barrel slung over his shoulder and a handgun tucked in to the back of his pants. The caption reads: "When they know they're your heart And you know you are their armor". This captioned picture was send with the message from Nick Worthing that "In my opinion if someone killed Eric verhille..it would be justified"
- 42. A search of the IP Addresses listed in the Facebook, Inc. warrant return indicate almost all connections the device that was used to connect to the internet to access the Facebook account of Nick Worthing was listed with an ISP belonging to Verizon Wireless. A subpoena has been served on Verizon Wireless.
- 43. Nicholas Worthing has a prior conviction for Violating a Protection Order on July 17, 2014, in AUGDC-CR-13-2311.
- Based on the above facts, I have probable cause to believe that Nicholas J. Worthing, date of birth who is more fully described as being 5'5", having blonde hair, hazel eyes, and weighing 135 pounds, has committed the crime of Stalking, in violation of 17-A MRSA § 210-A (1) (C), Class C.

In January 2017, Troop C requested Troop D Tpr. Erin James to serve a summons for harassment by electronic device to Nicholas Worthing of Pittston. Tpr. Verhille assisted Tpr. James in serving the summons at the Worthing residence.

Nicholas Worthing met the troopers at the door and let them inside. The troopers told them the purpose of their visit was to serve a criminal summons on him. Worthing became uncooperative and belligerent and refused to sign the summons. The troopers explained he had to sign the summons as an acknowledgment of him receiving it and it was not in any way considered admitting to guilt to anything. They told him it was a crime to not sign the summons and he could be arrested if he chose to refuse to sign it.

Tr. James told Worthing she was leaving the summons on the table for him and he needed to be there for the court hearing date. Tpr. Verhille saw that Worthing saw the summons left on his counter. Tpr. Verhille said a decision had been made not to arrest Worthing for his refusal to sign the summons, knowing they could have arrested him.

Tpr. Verhille said they then left his residence when a short time later, the RCC told the troopers Worthing had called asking why troopers had been to his house. The troopers came back to the Worthing residence. Worthing met the troopers on his property and asked why they were there. Tpr. Verhille said they had been there to serve him a summons. Worthing told them he didn't know they served a summons and asked where it was.

Tpr. Verhille told Worthing he would make sure he got his summons. Worthing then told the troopers to leave his property. The troopers told him he needed to sign the summons first. Worthing then called 911 on what appeared to be his cordless phone then ran inside his house. The troopers followed him through the door and told him once again he needed to sign the summons.

Worthing refused to sign the summons then told the dispatcher the troopers were pointing their guns at him. Tpr. Verhille said at no point did either trooper point their gun at Worthing and told him so. The dispatcher wanted to know if the troopers were all set while Worthing screamed and yelled, not letting them talk and getting out of control.

The troopers then took him down to the ground and arrested him for refusing to sign the summons. Tpr. Verhille said at this point Worthing completely deescalated. Worthing was then transported to jail.

Tpr. Verhille estimates that 3 to 4 weeks later, Tpr. Verhille's wife, received a message on Facebook Messenger. The message was received from the Facebook account from a person listed as "Nick Worthing".

The message to read: "Question. Do you ever think that your husband being a low-life douchebag arresting a single father of his eight-year-old daughter on a summons that is complete bull shit. Might affect your life? Have a good night...".

Tpr. Verhille took a screenshot of this message and he told his supervisor, Sgt. Pat Hood. Sgt. Hood said he thought he also received a Facebook message from "Nicholas Worthing".

Approximately one month later, Tpr. Verhille's mother, and the process are received a Facebook message from "Nicholas Worthing".

The message to read: "Your sons a scum bag. Who is no good at his job. That low life broke in to my house, illegal home invasion.....In my opinion that's why there's so many cop shootings, is because of gang members like him. Fucking scum bag."


A couple months later, Tpr. Verhille's father, received a Facebook message from "Nicholas Worthing".

Tpr. Verhille said his mother later received another Facebook message from "Nicholas Worthing" and his father received two more. This was sometime in June or July 2017. One of the messages talked about a girl in the who had recently been killed.

Tpr. Verhille said after several months of his family receiving continual threatening unsolicited messages, with no response from his family, with no sign of it stopping, he felt this was enough and something had to be done about it. END OF INTERVIEW

I read Nicholas "Nick" Worthing his Miranda rights. He explained his understanding of his Miranda rights then waived his rights and consented to be interviewed.

Nick said Tpr. Verhille came to see him concerning harassment involving Fowler Roofing.

Nick didn't see where there was any complaint as all the person had to do was block him on Facebook. An officer told Nick not to talk with the guy from Fowler Roofing but then the guy talked to Nick so Nick said he thought it was all good.

The next day, Tpr. Erin James and Tpr. Verhille told Nick he was getting a summons for harassing the Fowler Roofing guy. Tpr. James was the lead investigator.

Nick told the troopers he didn't need to sign the summons. Nick tried writing the trooper's names then Tpr. Verhille started running his mouth. Nick couldn't get why he was running his mouth. The troopers left and he couldn't find the summons. Nick wanted them to look at his phone.

Nick said he was being drunk and belligerent with the troopers. Nick had Tpr. Verhille's father as a teacher. The father tried to help Nick but then his son was complaining about Nick's spelling.

Nick said that's what upset him, Tpr. Verhille complaining about Nick's spelling. Nick called dispatch and was drunk and belligerent. Nick called the sergeant who told Nick he was going to show up but the sergeant lied to Nick and sent Eric instead.

Eric's sergeant is an officer and shouldn't lie. He's supposed to set an example to the public. That bothered Nick that the sergeant lied to him.

Nick told dispatch he didn't want Eric Verhille back at his residence and that there was no need for him to be aggressive because he spelled Eric's name wrong.

Eric showed up and Nick told Eric to get the fuck off his property. Nick said it was his right not to have Eric on his property and called 911. Sgt. Hood had told Nick he was going to see him, not Eric. The troopers arrived and pushed their way in his residence.

Nick said he called Public Safety specifically to keep him out of Nick's house. Nick told Sgt. Hood he didn't want Eric at his house. Sgt. Hood said he'd come but he didn't and lied and sent the one person in the country Nick said he didn't want at his house. Nick said he didn't want him there.

Nick said that's why he had problems because he ran his mouth because he was mad.

Nick said really what he was saying was he's frustrated

Nick said it wasn't like he was going to do anything but his emotions got the best of him then he runs his mouth and gets in trouble.

Nick is fearful when he drives his car at night because he ran his mouth and the cops will shoot him.

Nick said when he posted the messages he used his cellphone using "Messenger". Nick said it used to be called Facebook then Messenger which Nick thinks is still tied into Facebook.

Nick looks up who he wants to message then he writes something and sends it. The person receiving his message can decide whether or not they want to read it and if they want to block him.

Nick sent messages to Kennebec SO because they harass him by parking at the smelt camps, which is his and his father's business. Nick and his father have told them they are being dinks about it saying they can be on public property. They told Kennebec SO that's fine but don't hide behind our building.

Nick said he wrote things which weren't nice. Nick said in his opinion they should die because he didn't feel safe. Nick said to look at the news because the police shoot people.

Nick said he's dealt with

Nick said he wasn't saying he was going to do something, it was just his opinion. He said he doesn't feel protected and scared the police were going to pull him over for anything, harass him and break into his house. Nick said again he wasn't going to do anything and just wanted to be left alone.

Nick said when he couldn't reach Eric, he messaged his family to get someone to apologize.

Nick said when he sent messages on Facebook it was always from his cellphone. He doesn't know if the carrier is Verizon or not because it's pay as you go. He said his daughter is the one that mostly uses the laptop even though Nick's the administrator.

Nick said his cellphone number is March/April 2017 and had a different cellphone before that.

Nick said he never lent his cellphone to anyone other than his young daughter. Worthing, but he said solviously doesn't text from his cellphone. Nick said it was only him that sent the messages. He said he did not know his passcode. END OF INTERVIEW

  - 3. Any outbuildings associated with the residence at 14 Pittston, Maine.
  - 4. The person of Nicholas Worthing (DOB: Morthing 14 Worthing Road, Pittston, Maine. Nicholas Worthing is listed on his Maine Driver's License as an white adult male, 5'5", 135 pounds, with blonde hair and hazel eyes.

#### II. There is certain evidence or property, namely:

Based upon the foregoing, I respectfully submit there is probable cause to believe the following item(s) either contain evidence of or themselves constitute instrumentalities of the offense(s) of Stalking in violation of 17-A M.R.S. § 210-A, and should therefore be seized:

- i. Computers, portable electronic devices and digital storage media of any kind. As used both above and below, the terms "computers, portable electronic devices and digital storage media" include any electronic system or device capable of storing and/or processing data in digital form, including: central processing units; laptops, tablets or notebook computers; personal digital assistants; wireless communication devices such as telephone paging devices, beepers, and cellular telephones: peripheral input/output devises such as keyboards, printers, scanners, plotters, monitors, and drives intended for removal media; related communications devices such as modem, cables, and connections; storage media such as hard disk drivers, floppy disks, thumb drives, magnetic tapes, and memory chips; and security devices;
- ii. Records in any form indicative of occupancy or ownership of the premises described in the search warrant (the Premises);
- iii. Records or images in any form that indicate ownership or use of computers, portable electronic devices, digital storage media, camera or imaging equipment found in the Premises.
- 2. To further search the computers, portable electronic devices and digital storage media seized during the search of 14 Worthing Road, Pittston, Maine for the following:
  - i. Any records or images related to the crime of Stalking, including those targeting the family of Maine State Police Trooper Eric Verhille.
  - ii. Records in any form indicative of occupancy or ownership of the premises described in the search warrant (the Premises);
  - iii. Records or images in any form that indicate ownership or use of computers, portable electronic devices, digital storage media, camera or imaging equipment found in the Premises.

All of which constitute evidence of the crime of Stalking in violation of 17-A M.R.S. § 210-A.


# III. My conclusion that such probable cause exists is based on the following factual information:

- 1. I, Herbert Leighton, Detective for the Maine State Police Major Crimes Unit, make this affidavit in support of an application for a search and seizure warrant under Title 17-A, Chapter 3, Subchapters 10 & 11 as well as Rule 41B of the Maine Rules of Unified Criminal Procedure.
- 2. This affidavit is intended to show that there is sufficient probable cause for the requested search and seizure warrant and does not set forth all of my knowledge about this matter. The statements contained in this affidavit are based upon the following: my own personal knowledge; knowledge obtained from other individuals during my participation in this investigation, including other law enforcement officers; my review of records related to this investigation; communications with others who have knowledge of the events and circumstances described herein; and information gained through my training and experience.
- 3. On September 14<sup>th</sup>, 2017 I spoke with Eric Verhille, employed as a Maine State Police Trooper. He told me that on a day in January, 2017, he and another trooper went to serve a criminal summons on Nicholas Worthing, date of birth:

  at Nicholas Worthing's residence, 14 Worthing Road in Pittston, for the crime of Stalking (in relation to a separate matter). Tpr. Verhille described the stalking incident as "Cyber-Stalking", commonly known as repeatedly using electronic communications to harass, frighten and/or threaten someone.
- 4. Tpr. Verhille said Worthing refused to sign the criminal summons. Worthing was told the signature was only an acknowledgment of receipt of the summons, that it was legally required and was a separate arrestable offense for refusing to sign the summons. Worthing continued to refuse to sign the summons. Tpr. Verhille said he and his fellow trooper made the decision not to arrest Worthing, but left the summons on his table and told him what the summons was for and his court date.

- 5. Tpr. Verhille said a short time later, dispatchers told him Nicholas Worthing had just called, wanting to know why State Troopers were at his residence. Tpr. Verhille said he and the fellow trooper responded back to the Worthing residence, to find Worthing outside screaming at them to leave his property immediately. The troopers told Worthing they came back to re-summons him for the crime of Stalking and that he needed to sign the summons. Worthing dialed 911 from his cordless phone then ran inside his residence. The troopers followed him inside and told Worthing once again he needed to sign the summons.
- 6. Once inside, Worthing told the dispatcher on the line the troopers were pointing a gun at him. Tpr. Verhille said at no point did anyone point guns at Worthing.
  Worthing still refused to sign the summons and was arrested for refusing to sign.
- 7. Tpr. Verhille said his wife, at a later date, received the following message on her Facebook account from a person listed as "Nick Worthing": "Question. Do you ever think that your husband being a low-life douchebag arresting a single father of his eight-year-old daughter on a summons that is complete bull shit. Might affect your life? Have a good night...".
- 8. On September 20<sup>th</sup>, 2017 I interviewed said she received the Facebook message from "Nick Worthing" sometime in May, 2017. She said she had never heard of a Nick Worthing. She read the message "Nick Worthing" sent to her a few times trying to understand it and why she was asked why it might affect her life. Said it was the first time as a police officer's wife she didn't feel safe for her family as it was the first time anyone from her husband's work had ever tried to seek out her family. She asked her husband if she should be concerned and said she didn't sleep that night because she felt scared and afraid for her children and her family. Said her husband took a screenshot of the post.

- 9. On September 20<sup>th</sup>, 2017 I interviewed with the said she received a Facebook message from "Nick Worthing" which read: "Your sons a scum bag. Who is no good at his job. That low life broke in to my house, illegal home invasion.....In my opinion that's why there's so many cop shootings, is because of gang members like him. Fucking scum bag." After reading the message, said she was scared and didn't know why someone would write this to her. Said she was scared for her son.
- 10. On September 20<sup>th</sup>, 2017, I interviewed september, father of Tpr. Eric Verhille. said he first heard of Facebook messages from "Nick Worthing" being sent to his family from his daughter-in-law, who confided to him she was scared and didn't know if she should tell her husband for fear of an escalation occurring if he were to learn what "Nick Worthing" wrote to her said his wife, was the second person in his family to receive a message from "Nick Worthing." See aid his wife was upset and afraid their son might get hurt not knowing how crazy the person might be.
- was sent sometime in June 2017. Said he received 3 Facebook messages from "Nick Worthing" in a short time span sometime the third week of August 2017. The messages together read: "Your sons going to lern...Sorry bout it // You got good looking grandchildren...schools starting soon // Your sons a no good child molester and I'm going to make sure everybody in this community knows what that scumbag is".
- 12. remembered Nick Worthing from at least 10 years ago where was a teacher at Gardner High School when Nick was a student there. The only thing remembered about Nick was he was a trouble-maker and had a temper.



- 13. Said his stomach became upset when he read these messages from "Nick Worthing" on his Facebook account felt the messages sent to his family were threatening and worried he might do something to his grandchildren, remembering the type of temper he had in high school. wondered what his wife, daughter-in-law and his grandchildren had to do with anything and continues to be concerned why this individual would seek his family out.
- 14. In my interview with some on September 20<sup>th</sup>, 2017, she said once she learned her father-in-law had received a Facebook message from "Nick Worthing", she checked her Facebook account to see if any more messages had come in. said she then read a new message from "Nick Worthing", that had been sent on June 28<sup>th</sup>, 2017, which read: "You got some cute kids. How would you feel if you had a armed home invasion for no reason?.....".
- 15. said she received a third Facebook message from "Nick Worthing", which was sent on Friday, September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2017. The message read: "Not the heck well I guess it's a positive thing that high school student died. at least Eric can't rape her". Tpr. Verhille told me the high school student referred to in the message was a August, 31<sup>st</sup>, 2017.
- 16. On September 14<sup>th</sup>, 2017, an email was forwarded to this affiant that was originally sent to members of the Kennebec County Sheriff's Office from Kennebec County Sheriff's Office Criminal Intelligence Analyst Randall Parker on August 30<sup>th</sup>, 2017. Analyst Parker listed screenshots of posts Nick Worthing posted on the Kennebec County Sheriff's Office Facebook page between January through August 2017. A January 25<sup>th</sup>, 2017 post read: "..?...There's a lot of ppl not happy...Hello?...We know your homes.. Like your gang like to attack us



at...Question. How would your kids feel of people showing up at your house...?

Just a question because you douchebags would do it to us...Have a good night".


- 17. A May 29<sup>th</sup>, 2017 post send by Nick Worthing to the Kennebec County Sheriff's Office read: "Break into my house with no justified reason and there was no reason. Just ignorance. Why don't you go take out the f\*\*\*\*\* druggies around. "we can't just break into people's houses." You did it to me cunt heads! Fuck you low lifes! Most of this recent stuff is because of that no-good low-life Eric verhill. he's a state cop but all you lowlife's are all the same. I guess whatever happens. You had a heads up".
- 18. The final post Nick Worthing sent to the Kennebec County Sheriff's Office Facebook page read: "Be careful you never know what could happen at a safety check".
- 19. On September 15<sup>th</sup>, 2017, Facebook, Inc., confirmed receipt of a Preservation Request to preserve the Facebook account of "Nick Worthing" and the listed URL (web address) connected to the account. Facebook, Inc. stated they would take reasonable steps to preserve the account for 90 days.
- 20. A URL is a uniform resource locator, abbreviated as URL (also known as web address, particularly when used with <u>HTTP</u>), is a specific <u>character string</u> that constitutes a reference to a resource. In most <u>web browsers</u>, the URL of a web page is displayed on top, inside an <u>address bar</u>. An example of a typical URL would be "http://en.example.org/wiki/Main\_Page".
- 21. On September 25<sup>th</sup>, 2017, I received a document from Maine State Police Troop D Commander, Lt. Aaron Hayden, of Facebook messages sent to the Facebook account of the Kennebec County Sheriff's Department from "Nick Worthing". One message read: "In my opinion if someone killed Eric verhille..It would be justified but I know that's just in my opinion....I'm just a daddy trying to protect his daughter but with scumbags like you out there...Idk...". Directly below this message was a picture of an adult male holding hands with a young girl, walking away from the camera, with a handgun tucked in the back waist area of the man, with what looks like a rifle strap on his back. The caption to the picture read: "When they know they're your heart And you know you are their armor

- 22. Another message listed in this document from "Nick Worthing", posted to the Facebook account of the Kennebec County Sheriff's Department talked about police officers trespassing "at the Smelt Camps". "Nick Worthing" wrote: "I'm thinking we could do a citizen's arrest for somebody trespassing with a deadly weapon...I believe that's are right...? Isn't it?". A third message read: "In my opinion a dog is to Serve and Protect but if that dog bites you, it should get a bullet right in the f\*\*\*\*\* head.. Just my opinion". This was followed by a Smiley Face with a wink.
- 23. On September 25<sup>th</sup>, I received a document from Katharine England from the Maine Department of Public Safety. The document included several messages sent to the Facebook account of the Maine State Police from "Nick Worthing" from June 14<sup>th</sup>, 2017 to June 19<sup>th</sup>, 2017. The messages open with: "Scum bags do your fucking job arrest at low life verhill for doing an illegal home invasion...Or are you just a gang that the public should rise up against?" After a series of posts, "Nick Worthing" writes: "Question. Am I able to go do my own citizen's arrest? What's required to do that? Since your game does not want to fallow the law...". "In my opinion if someone did an armed home invasion, that person should be in jail.....". "And in my opinion this is why you see the stuff that happens to Cops on TV".
- 24. "Nick Worthing" continues on then writes: "Cant say i didnt try to talk this out...Whatever happens happens...Just know I felt threatened for my life and my daughters with criminals breaking in to my home".
- 25. Lt. Aaron Hayden told me that, as a result of the messages "Nick Worthing" posted to the Maine State Police Facebook account, the Facebook account of "Nick Worthing" has been blocked. Lt. Hayden said to date, "Nick Worthing" has been the only account blocked on the Maine State Police Facebook page since its inception.

- 28. On 04/24/17 at 11:54PM (UTC) and again on 07/22/17 at 10:52PM (UTC), the Facebook account of Nick Worthing searched for the Facebook account of "Eric Verhille".
- 29. On 04-24-17 at 11:57PM (UTC), 06-11-17 at 10:55AM (UTC), 06/22/17 at 11:01PM (UTC), and again on 08/31/17 at 5:41PM (UTC), the Facebook account of Nick Worthing searched for the photographs of the Facebook account of "Eric Verhille".
- 30. On 09/01/17 at 2:27PM (UTC), the Facebook account of Nick Worthing searched for the Facebook account of "the Facebook". State Police Trooper Eric Verhille.
- 31. On 03/28/17 at 10:34AM (UTC), on 04/24/17 at 11:55PM (UTC), and again on 06/14/17 at 5:13AM (UTC), the Facebook account of Nick Worthing searched for the Facebook account of 'Company'. State Police Trooper Eric Verhille.
- 32. On 03/28/17 at 10:34AM (UTC), the Facebook account of Nick Worthing searched for the Facebook account of "facebook". It is the wife of Maine State Police Trooper Eric Verhille.
- 33. On 06-14-17 at 5:09AM (UTC), the Facebook account of Nick Worthing sent the following message to the Facebook account of 'Manuel State Police Trooper Eric Verhille:
  - "Your sons a scum bag. Who is no good at his job. That low life broke in to my house, illegal home invasion.....In my opinion that's why there's so many cop shootings, is because of gang members like him. Fucking scum bag."
- 34. On 08-24-17 at 10:22PM (UTC), the Facebook account of Nick Worthing sent the following message to the Facebook account of "facebook", father of Maine State Police Trooper Eric Verhille.
- "Your sons going to lern...Sorry:bout it" and "You got good looking grandchildren...schools starting soon"
- 35. On 04-21-17 at 4:35PM (UTC), the Facebook account of Nick Worthing sent the following message to the Facebook account of the Maine State Police: "You're just a bunch of low-life scumbag gang. I wish I was proud of the police department but no you're low-life. Tell srg. Hood suck my dick. Pussy cant even show up. I bet he's a child molester. Sick fuck...Scom bags harass me with a

summons that the District Attorney's office didn't even want to stick up for. All of you are lazy. Collecting welfare off of the Working Man, you pieces of shit!"


36. On 04-13-17 at 7:53AM (UTC), the Facebook account of Nick Worthing sent the following message to the personal Facebook account of Maine State Police Sergeant Patrick Hood:

"You're a skum bag. That's no good at your job. You give cops a bad name. You lieing fuck. Don't have the balls to show. Send a pee on ha. You know your summons was Bull shit. Lol the d.a. didn't even stick up for it you stupid dumb fuck. I love how my security cameras caught your officers abusing their power. I go around showing the pubic. I think that's the way to fight your gang. let the public see what kind of scumbag gang you guys are...Please Don't Shoot Me n Call of Justified, that's what you gang members are known for...Scum bags.

37. On several instances, at various dates, the Facebook account of Nick Worthing sent the following messages to the Facebook account of the Kennebec County Sheriff's Office:

"In my opinion of someone killed Eric verhill..It would be justified but I know that's just in my opinion.....I'm just a daddy trying to protect his daughter but with scumbags like you out there...Idk..."

"Do you help rape children? I bet holds them down...Scum bags!"




"In my opinion a dog is to Serve and Protect but if that dog bites you, it should get a bullet right in the f\*\*\*\*\* head. Just my opinion"

"I'm thinking we could do a citizen's arrest for somebody trespassing with a deadly weapon...I believe that's are right....? Isn't it? And don't say that I don't have the right to."

"I bet you if Eric verhill was breaking into your home to molesting your children he be in jail.....You worthless scum bags"

- 38. The Facebook Inc., record return confirmed the picture referred to previously in this affidavit send to the Kennebec County Sheriff's Office from the Facebook account of Nick Worthing with a colored picture of an adult male holding the hand of a young girl walking across a bridge away from the camera, and clearly holding a long gun in his left hand with barrel slung over his shoulder and a handgun tucked in to the back of his pants. The caption reads: "When they know they're your heart And you know you are their armor". This captioned picture was send with the message from Nick Worthing that "In my opinion if someone killed Eric verhille..it would be justified"
- 39. A search of the IP Addresses listed in the Facebook, Inc. warrant return indicate almost all connections the device that was used to connect to the internet to access the Facebook account of Nick Worthing was listed with an ISP belonging to Verizon Wireless.

#### IV. My education, training and experience may be summarized as follows:

I have been a Maine law enforcement officer since 1985, a sworn member of the Maine State Police since 1988 and a detective with the State Police Major Crimes Unit since February 1995. I am a founding member of the Maine State Police Evidence Response Team, having held the position of Team Commander from 2004 to 2015 when I retired from the team. I continue to maintain a forensic specialty in Bloodstain Pattern Analysis/Crime Scene Reconstruction since 1997 and am the founding member of the Maine State Police Bloodstain Pattern Analysis Program.

- V. Based on my education, training and experience, and the facts set forth in this affidavit, there is probable cause to believe, and I do believe, the following:
- 1. That a computer, portable electronic device or other digital media with the ability to access the internet or store media files is located at the residence at 14 Worthing Road, Pittston, Maine, as described above in Part I, and was recently used to commit the crime of Stalking in violation of 17-A M.R.S.A. § 210-A.

- 2. That the residence at 14 Worthing Road, Pittston, Maine, as described above in Part I, contains computers, portable electronic devices and computer-related equipment, as described above in Part II, that were used as instrumentalities in, and that contain evidence of, the commission of the crimes of possession and dissemination of sexually explicit material.
- 3. That careful off-site forensic examination of a computer, portable electronic devices or other electronic data storage device by a trained examiner in a forensic laboratory, such as those maintained by the Maine State Police Computer Crimes Unit, will result in the recovery of electronic data that has been stored on the computer, even if the data was not intentionally stored, was deleted, was password-protected or encrypted, and often even if the computer itself has been damaged.
- 4. That forensic examination of electronic data may require the use of software and/or written materials regarding the computer equipment and software that were used to store or retrieve the data, including owner's manuals, computer reference books, guides, written notes, and recorded passwords.
- 5. That such recoverable electronic data includes the P2P software, Internet history (including internet browser history, search engine history, temporary internet files), electronic communications (such as email and email attachments, chat room communications, writings created on word processing software, notepads, etc.), stored data files and folders, graphic visual images (such as photographs, movie clips and scanned images), personal calendars or diaries, and any other electronic data that demonstrates the identity of the person who exercised dominion or control over the computer or its contents.
- 6. That such electronically stored data may also exist in the form of paper printouts or stored on digital storage media.
- 7. If at the time of the execution of the approved search warrant, the residents of 14 Worthing Road, Pittston, Maine are not present, attempts to notify will be made. Any residents who do arrive will be searched pursuant to the warrant.
- 8. I spoke with Maine State Police Sergeant Christopher Tupper, of the Maine State Police Computer Crimes Unit, who reviewed this affidavit and told me there may be evidence and/or artifacts linking electronic devices to the Facebook account of Nicholas Worthing and the crime of Stalking in violation of 17-A M.R.S.A. § 210-A.

9. This affidavit was reviewed by Assistant District Attorney Alisa Ross with the Kennebec County District Attorney's Office.

WHEREFORE, I pray that a warrant may issue authorizing a search of the Property/Premises described above in Part I for the Property/Evidence described above in Part II, and that if such Property/Evidence be found that it shall be seized.

I further request that this warrant authorize the subsequent examination of the contents of any seized computer equipment by the Maine State Police Computer Crimes Unit, or any other State or federal law enforcement agency qualified to do so, and that it authorize the assistance of civilian employees of the Maine Department of Public Safety assigned to the Maine State Police Computer Crimes Unit.

I hereby swear under pains and penalties of perjury that the facts set forth in this affidavit are true and correct to the best of my information and belief.

This Court is authorized to issue this warrant pursuant to 15 M.R.S. §§55 & 56, M.R.U. Crim.P 41 and 41B.

Part III: My conclusion that such probable cause exists is based on the following factual information:

## A. INTRODUCTON

- 1. I, Herbert Leighton, Detective for the Maine State Police Major Crimes Unit, make this affidavit in support of an application for a search and seizure warrant under Title 17-A, Chapter 3, Subchapters 10 & 11 as well as Rule 41B of the Maine Rules of Unified Criminal Procedure to require Facebook, Inc. to disclose to the government records and other information in its possession pertaining to the subscriber or customer associated with the accounts, including the contents of communications.
- 2. This affidavit is intended to show that there is sufficient probable cause for the requested search and seizure warrant and does not set forth all of my knowledge about this matter. The statements contained in this affidavit are based upon the following: my own personal knowledge; knowledge obtained from other individuals during my participation in this investigation, including other law enforcement officers; my review of records related to this investigation; communications with others who have knowledge of the events and circumstances described herein; and information gained through my training and experience.

### B. EXPERIENCE

My education, training and experience may be summarized as follows:

I have been a Maine law enforcement officer since 1985, a sworn member of the Maine State Police since 1988 and a detective with the State Police Major Crimes Unit since February 1995. I am a founding member of the Maine State Police Evidence Response Team, having held the position of Team Commander from 2004 to 2015 when I retired from the team. I continue to maintain a forensic specialty in Bloodstain Pattern Analysis/Crime Scene Reconstruction since 1997 and am the founding member of the Maine State Police Bloodstain Pattern Analysis Program.

### C. STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

- 1. On September 14th, 2017 I spoke with Eric Verhille, employed as a Maine State Police

  Trooper. He told me that on a day in January, 2017, he and another trooper served a criminal summons on Nicholas Worthing, date of birth: Nicholas Worthing's residence, 14

  Worthing Road in Pittston, for the crime of Stalking. Tpr. Verhille described the stalking incident as "Cyber-Stalking", commonly known as repeatedly using electronic communications to harass, frighten and/or threaten someone.
- 2. Tpr. Verhille said Worthing refused to sign the criminal summons. Worthing was told the signature was only an acknowledgment of receipt of the summons, that is was legally required and was a separate arrestable offense for refusing to sign the summons. Worthing continued to refuse to sign the summons. Tpr. Verhille said he and his fellow trooper made the decision not to arrest Worthing, but left the summons on his table and told him what the summons was for and his court date.
- 3. Tpr. Verhille said a short time later, dispatchers told him Nicholas Worthing had just called, wanting to know why State Troopers were at his residence. Tpr. Verhille said he and the fellow trooper responded back to the Worthing residence, to find Worthing outside screaming at them to leave his property immediately. The troopers told Worthing they came back to resummons him for the crime of Stalking and that he needed to sign the summons. Worthing dialed 911 from his cordless phone then ran inside his residence. The troopers followed him inside and told Worthing once again he needed to sign the summons.
- 4. Once inside, Worthing told the dispatcher on the line the troopers were pointing a gun at him.

  Tpr. Verhille said at no point did anyone point guns at Worthing. Worthing still refused to sign the summons and was arrested for refusing to sign.
- 5. Tpr. Verhille said his wife, at a later date, received the following message on her Facebook account from a person listed as "Nick Worthing": "Question. Do you ever think that your husband being a low-life douchebag arresting a single father of his eight-year-old daughter on a summons that is complete bull shit. Might affect your life? Have a good night...".

- 6. On September 20th, 2017 I interviewed said she received the message from "Nick Worthing" sometime in May, 2017. She said she had never heard of a Nick Worthing. She read the message "Nick Worthing" sent to her a few times trying to understand it and why she was asked why it might affect her life. Said it was the first time as a police officer's wife she didn't feel safe for her family as it was the first time anyone from her husband's work had ever tried to seek out her family. She asked her husband if she should be concerned and said she didn't sleep that night because she felt scared and afraid for her children and her family. Said her husband took a screenshot of the post.
- 7. On September 20th, 2017 I interviewed message from "Nick Worthing" which read: "Your sons a scumbag. Who is no good at his job. That low life broke in to my house, illegal home invasion.....In my opinion that's why there's so many cop shootings, is because of gang members like him. Fucking scumbag." After reading the message, said she was scared and didn't know why someone would write this to her. Said she was scared for her son. Said she took a screenshot of the message.
- 8. On September 20th, 2017, I interviewed the first heard of Facebook messages from "Nick Worthing" being sent to his family from his daughter-in-law, who confided to him she was scared and didn't know if she should tell her husband for fear of an escalation occurring if he were to learn what "Nick Worthing" wrote to her. Said his wife, was the second person in his family to receive a message from "Nick Worthing. Said his wife was upset and afraid their son might get hurt no knowing how crazy the person might be.
- 9. said he thought the Facebook message sent to his wife from "Nick Worthing" was sent sometime in June 2017. said he received 3 Facebook messages from "Nick Worthing" in a short time span sometime the third week of August 2017. The messages together read:

"Your sons going to lern...Sorry bout it // You got good looking grandchildren....schools starting soon // Your sons a no good child molester and I'm going to make sure everybody in this community knows what that scumbag is".

- 10. Gardner High School when Nick was a student there. The only thing remembered about Nick was a trouble-maker and had a temper. The membered no specific conflict between himself and Nick Worthing and has had no contact with him since high school.
- 11. said his stomach became upset when he read these messages from "Nick Worthing" on his Facebook account. felt the messages sent to his family were threatening and worried he might do something to his grandchildren, remembering the type of temper he had in high school. wondered what his wife, daughter-in-law and his grandchildren had to do with anything and continues to be concerned why this individual would seek his family out.
- 12. In my interview with some on September 20th, 2017, she said once she learned her father-in-law had received a Facebook message from "Nick Worthing", she checked her Facebook account to see if any more messages had come in. said she then read a new message from "Nick Worthing", that had been sent on June 28th, 2017, which read: "You got some cute kids. How would you feel if you had a armed home invasion for no reason?.....".
- 13. Said she received a third Facebook message from "Nick Worthing", which was sent on Friday, September 1st, 2017. The message read: "Not the heck well I guess it's a positive thing that high school student died. at least Eric can't rape her". Tpr. Verhille told me the high school student referred to in the message was Maine, who died message was no August, 31st, 2017.
- 14. On September 14th, 2017, an email was forwarded to this affiant that was originally sent to members of the Kennebec County Sheriff's Office from Kennebec County Sheriff's Office Criminal Intelligence Analyst Randall Parker on August 30th, 2017. Analyst Parker listed screenshots of posts Nick Worthing posted on the Kennebec County Sheriff's Office Facebook page between January through August 2017. A January 25th, 2017 post read: "...?...There's a

lot of ppl not happy...Hello?...We know your homes.. Like your gang like to attack us at... Question. How would your kids feel of people showing up at your house...? Just a question because you douchebags would do it to us...Have a good night".

- 15. A May 29th, 2017 post send by Nick Worthing to the Kennebec County Sheriff's Office read: "Break into my house with no justified reason and there was no reason. Just ignorance. Why don't you go take out the f\*\*\*\*\* druggies around. "we can't just break into people's houses." You did it to me cunt heads! Fuck you low lifes! Most of this recent stuff is because of that no-good low-life Eric verhill. he's a state cop but all you lowlife's are all the same. I guess whatever happens. You had a heads up".
- 16. The final post Nick Worthing sent to the Kennebec County Sheriff's Office Facebook page read: "Be careful you never know what could happen at a safety check".
- 17. On September 15th, 2017, Facebook, Inc., confirmed receipt of a Preservation Request to preserve the Facebook account of "Nick Worthing" and the listed URL (web address) connected to the account. Facebook, Inc. stated they would take reasonable steps to preserve the account for 90 days.
- 18. A URL is a uniform resource locator, abbreviated as URL (also known as web address, particularly when used with <u>HTTP</u>), is a specific <u>character string</u> that constitutes a reference to a resource. In most <u>web browsers</u>, the URL of a web page is displayed on top, inside an <u>address bar</u>. An example of a typical URL would be "http://en.example.org/wiki/Main\_Page".
- 19. On September 25th, 2017, I received a document from Maine State Police Troop D Commander, Lt. Aaron Hayden, of Facebook messages sent to the Facebook account of the Kennebec County Sheriff's Department from "Nick Worthing". One message read: "In my opinion if someone killed Eric verhille...It would be justified but I know that's just in my opinion....I'm just a daddy trying to protect his daughter but with scumbags like you out there...Idk...". Directly below this message was a picture of an adult male holding hands with a young girl, walking away from the camera, with a handgun tucked in the back waist area of the man, with what looks like a rifle strap on his back. The caption to the picture read: "When they know they're your heart And you know you are their armor And you will destroy anyone who would try to harm her". Below this post was an illustration of a large thumb's up from "Nick Worthing".

- 20. Another message listed in this document from "Nick Worthing", posted to the Facebook account of the Kennebec County Sheriff's Department talked about police officers trespassing "at the Smelt Camps". "Nick Worthing" wrote: "I'm thinking we could do a citizen's arrest for somebody trespassing with a deadly weapon...I believe that's are right...? Isn't it?". A third message read: "In my opinion a dog is to Serve and Protect but if that dog bites you, it should get a bullet right in the f\*\*\*\*\* head.. Just my opinion". This was followed by a Smiley Face with a wink.
- 21. On September 25th, I received a document from Katharine England from the Maine Department of Public Safety. The document included several messages sent to the Facebook account of the Maine State Police from "Nick Worthing" from June 14th, 2017 to June 19th, 2017. The messages open with: "Scum bags do your fucking job arrest at low life verhill for doing an illegal home invasion...Or are you just a gang that the public should rise up against?" After a series of posts, "Nick Worthing" writes: "Question. Am I able to go do my own citizen's arrest? What's required to do that? Since your game does not want to fallow the law...". "In my opinion if someone did an armed home invasion, that person should be in jail.....". "And in my opinion this is why you see the stuff that happens to Cops on TV".
- 22. "Nick Worthing" continues on then writes: "Cant say i didnt try to talk this out... Whatever happens happens...Just know I felt threatened for my life and my daughters with criminals breaking in to my home".
- 23. Lt. Aaron Hayden told me that, as a result of the messages "Nick Worthing" posted to the Maine State Police Facebook account, the Facebook account of "Nick Worthing" has been blocked. Lt. Hayden said to date, "Nick Worthing" has been the only account blocked on the Maine State Police Facebook page since its inception.
- 24. This affidavit was reviewed by Deputy District Attorney General Paul Cavanaugh. DDA Cavanaugh has been a prosecutor for over 25 years and has reviewed hundreds of search warrants.

# PART IV: Based upon my education, training, experience and the facts made known to me set forth in this affidavit, your affiant believes the following:

- 1. That located in the Facebook account described above in Part I, evidence will be located which would reveal the identity of the person actually engaging in the conduct of Stalking.
- 2. Electronic data stored in the above described account such as IP Connection logs and Cookies may link Nicholas Worthing to a device or an internet connection.

3. A Cookie is a text file placed on your device by the site you are visiting. The Cookie can contain a lot of information about your browsing history on the particular website. The Cookie is unique to a particular device. Additionally the above described account may hold other viable information which will link a particular user to the crime of Stalking, pursuant to Title 17-A M.R.S.§210(A).

#### PART V: WAIVER AND PRECLUDING NOTICE

Your affiant is requesting that this court make a finding of an ADVERSE RESULT under Title 15 M.R.S. § 56 for the following reason. At this time, the subject has not been informed of this investigation. If the subject is notified of this investigation, the individual can delete material that is stored remotely as well as any remaining digital material that exists locally resulting in the destruction or tampering with evidence and/or potentially jeopardizing the investigation. Accordingly, I am requesting that the Court order that Facebook not notify the individual of this request and, similarly, that notice of receipt of the material also be waived for your affiant.

I respectfully request that civilian employees of Facebook, Inc. be authorized to assist in this search warrant. I further request that the warrant authorize the subsequent examination of the contents of the material provided by computer forensic examiners from the Maine State Police Computer Crimes Unit, or any other State or federal law enforcement agencies qualified to do so, and that it also authorize the assistance of civilian employees of such law enforcement agencies.

WHEREFORE, I pray that a warrant may issue authorizing a search of the Property/Premises described above in Part I for the Property/Evidence described above in Part II, and that if such Property/Evidence be found that it shall be seized.
